



Approximately 30 distinguished speakers offering insights from leading experts in the field.



Getting to Scandic Copenhagen

- **From Copenhagen Airport (CPH):** The hotel is approximately 12 kilometres from the airport, with travel options including:
- **By Taxi:** A taxi ride typically takes about 20 minutes, depending on traffic.
- **Public Transport:** The metro line M2 runs from the airport to the city centre. Change at Kongens Nytorv to the M3 or M4 lines, and alight at Vesterport Station, which is just a short walk from the hotel. The total journey time is around 30 minutes.
- **From Copenhagen Central Station:** Scandic Copenhagen is just 600 metres away, making it a quick 7-minute walk. Alternatively, one can take a bus or a taxi for a minimal travel time.
- **By Car:** For those driving, the hotel offers parking facilities. It is easily accessible via major motorways, ensuring smooth arrival regardless of direction.
